



TUESDAY NIGHT TRAP FUN SHOOT

PRIZES

Prizes-awards will be given for HOA and class winners. Classes will be determined post event using Lewis Class procedures. A new class will be created for at least every 10 shooters.

When: Tuesday Evenings (shooting begins at 6:00pm, registration at 5:30 pm). In case of bad weather, check the Cedar City Gun Club website for cancellation notices at <http://www.cedarcitygunclub.com>

Entry Fee: \$10

Format: 50 targets (2 –25 target rounds). Shooting / scoring rules will follow ATA guidelines unless otherwise stated in the event rules.

Awards: HOA and class winners will receive recognition. Classes will be divided up after the shooting is completed into groups of at least 10 people (depending on number of shooters) using Lewis Class procedures. Complete rules are listed below.

Registration: Registration will be available the day of the shoot. Registration will be limited to 50 shooters (10 squads) because of time constraints.

SCHEDULE

5:30 p.m.	Registration Begins
6:00 p.m.	First squads take the line

Rules for the distribution of prizes : Prizes will be given to the high shooter in each class. Classes (and therefore prize winners) will be established after shooting is completed. The number of classes will be determined by dividing the number of entrants by 10 and discarding the remainder. Here are three examples to demonstrate the method:

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|----------------|-----------|-----------------------------------|
| 1. 21 entrants | 2 classes | 1 class of 10 and 1 class of 11 |
| 2. 27 entrants | 2 classes | 1 class of 13 and 1 class of 14 |
| 3. 35 entrants | 3 classes | 1 class of 11 and 2 classes of 12 |
| 4. 54 entrants | 5 classes | 1 class of 10 and 4 classes of 11 |

At the conclusion of the event, all of the scores will be listed in descending order then the class lines will be drawn using the method mentioned above.

- Short group(s) created by odd numbers of entrants will always be the upper group(s).
- When class lines are drawn between ties, the tied scores will stay in the majority group.
- If equal ties exist above and below the class line then the ties will be moved to the head of the lower group.
- If the class lines have to be adjusted because of ties then only the affected classes will be modified, all of the other original class lines will remain intact.

Once the winning scores for each class have been determined, ties will be broken using a “shoot and out” shoot off starting at the 24 yard line and moving back one yard until only one shooter has not missed. Post assignments will be randomly determined
